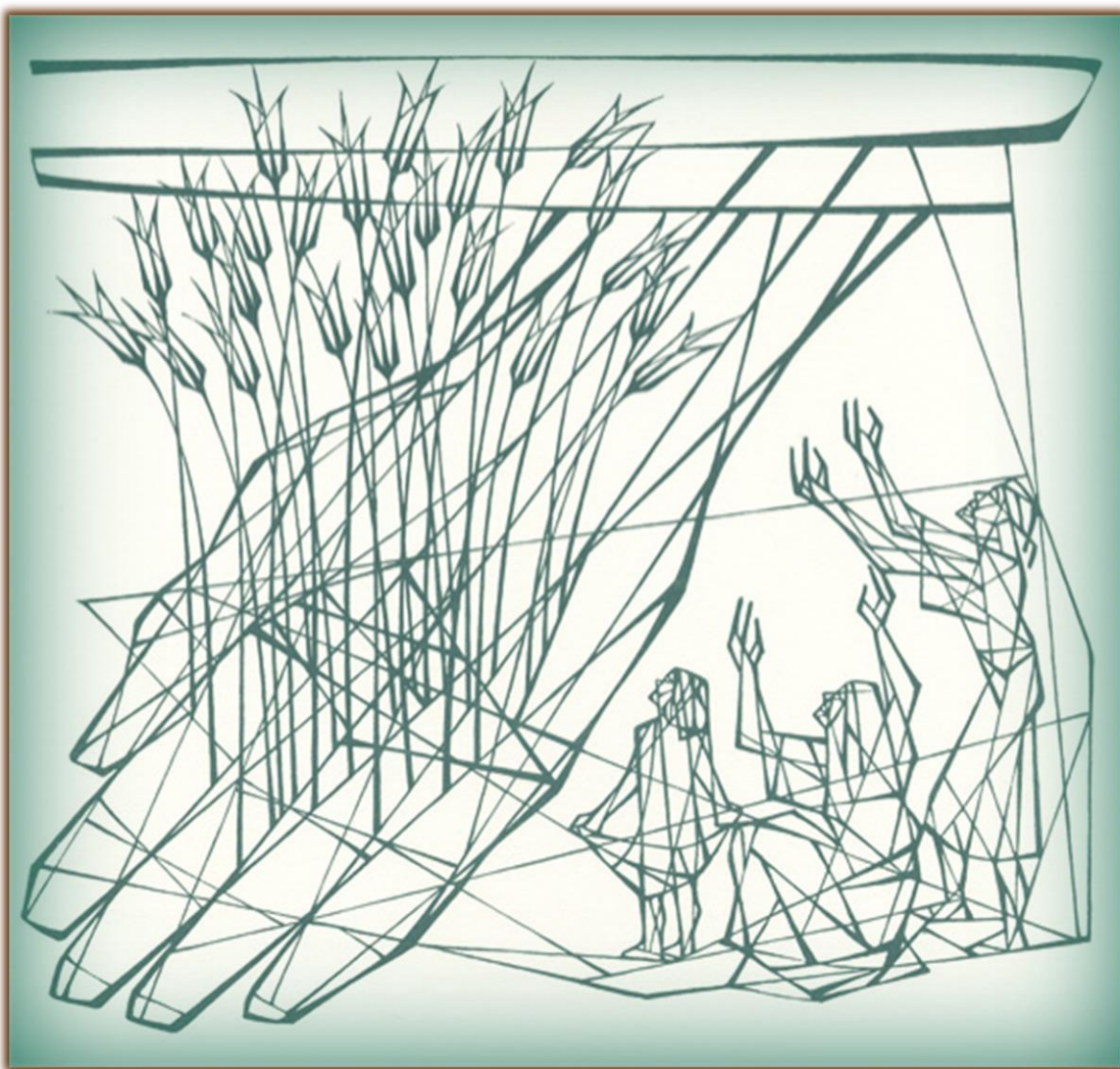

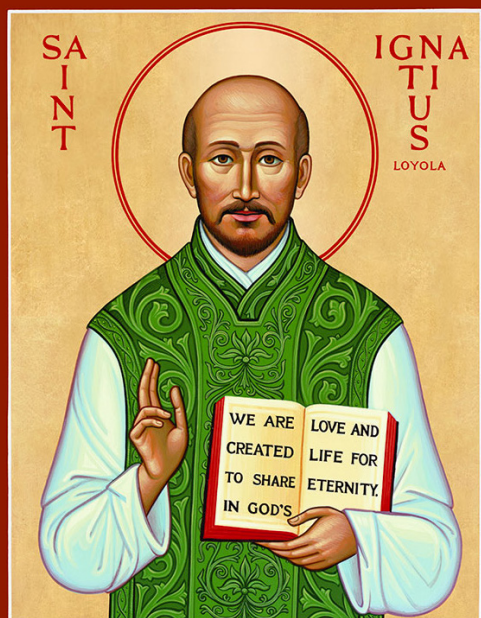

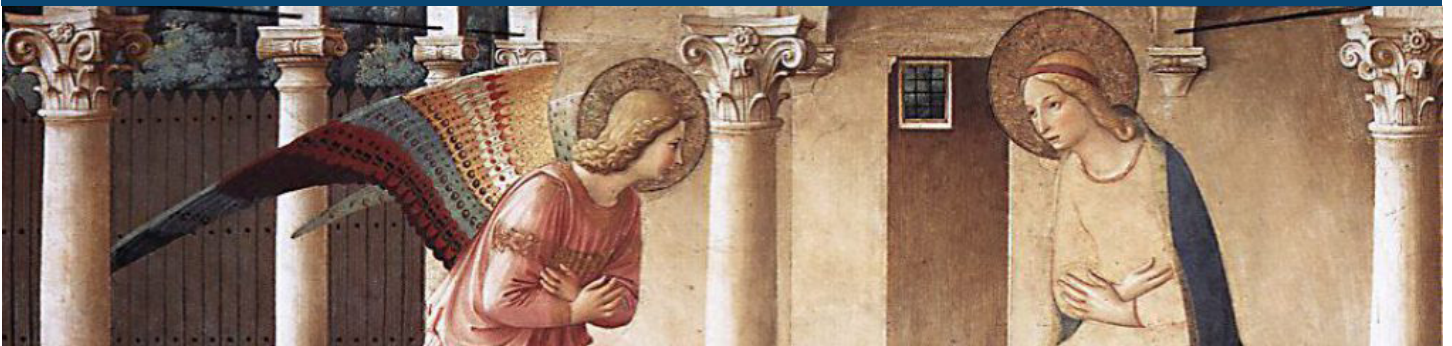
Author of Growing in Love and Wisdom:

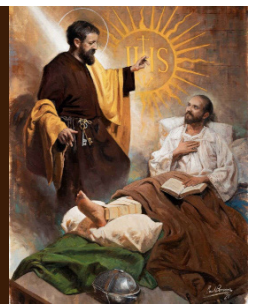


Ignatian Year Postage Stamp

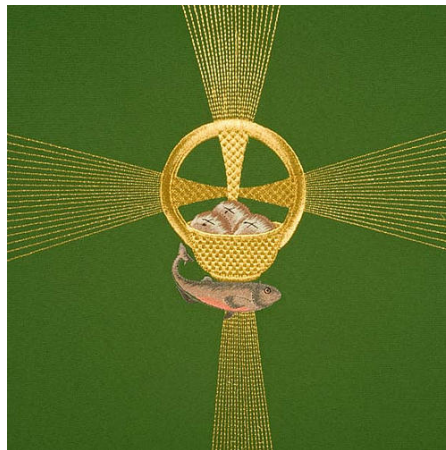
