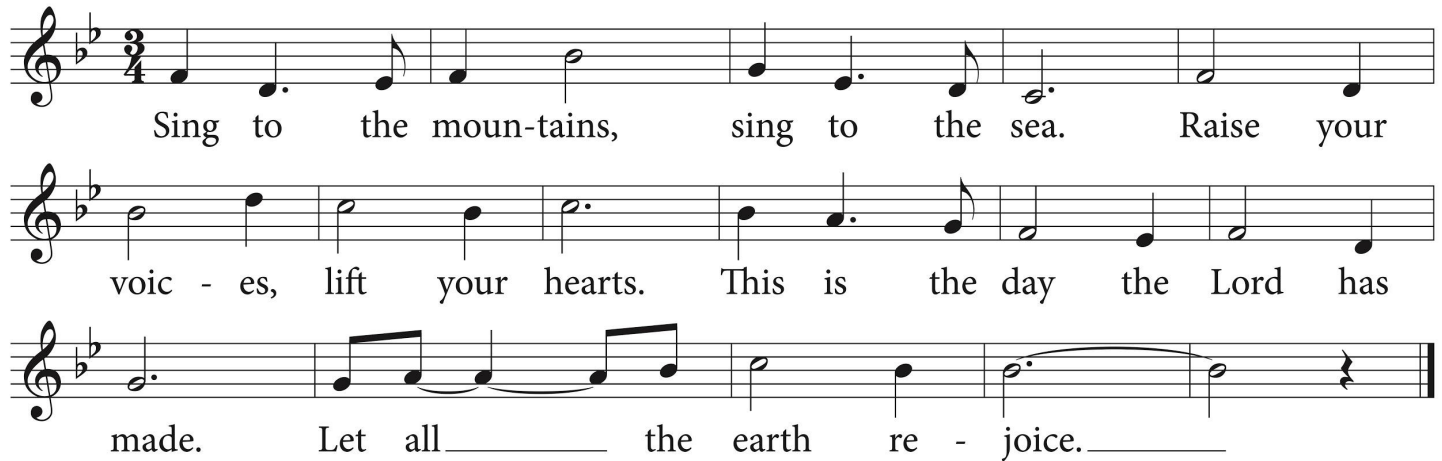
**The Lord's Prayer** *in song and gesture*
